

**REVISED DECLARATION FORM FOR SENIOR ADULT**



**2021 Making Choices about Attending Mass (High Risk Groups)**

Under the MKN SOP for Non-Muslim Places of Worship under CMCO dated 4th March 2021, persons aged 60 years and above and children below the age of 12 are “not encouraged” to attend public gatherings.

The Archdiocesan Policy as per Archbishop Julian’s Pastoral Letter dated 11th July 2020, entitled “Resumption of Sacramental Life under Phase 3” reiterates the above principle on the grounds of public health advisories. Due to the higher risk, the Archdiocese discourages those falling under the above categories from attending public Masses. Please note that the Archbishop has dispensed the faithful from attending Masses on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. We are also providing streamed Masses for those who are unable to come.

If you are planning to return to public Mass after having been made aware of the above guidelines and SOP, kindly consult your family members/caregivers and physician and weigh the risks for yourself and others, before deciding to come for Mass.
